Overview

Action funded by the European Commission through the **Caroline Herschel – FPCUP programme**

7 partners: Eurisy, Pôle SAFE, SERTIT, IRISPACE, Pôle Mer Bretagne Atlantique, Aerospace Valley, DLR and CNES

Coordinated by the French Space Agency (CNES)

Duration: 18 months

Objectives

To promote and foster the operational use of **Copernicus data and services** through the implementation of activities **at the local level**

To respond to the actual needs and issues of **Local and Regional Authorities (LRAs)**

Mean: **Knowledge and experience sharing** among French and European regions and at promoting the operational uses of Copernicus data and services by LRAs

Target audiences

Copernicus users (LRA and non-space SMEs) and **service providers** are the main target of this action

The activities will put forward **the experience, needs and feedback** of users and service providers, which are considered as the best ambassadors to promote Copernicus uses

Activities

Today: A **launch event** to present the scope, objectives, planned activities and expected results of the action

Implementation **by the three regional partners** of a set of activities adapted to the needs and maturity of the user community (in particular, LRAs and service providers)

The three targeted territories are the **Brittany Region** and the **Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Region** (Sud-PACA) in France, and the **tri-national Eurodistrict of Basel** (France – Germany - Switzerland)

Activities

Two workshops, respectively in a French and a European region, to promote **companies' business development** towards LRAs and space clusters

Design of a “**Copernicus City Award**”

Co-building of Copernicus-derived indicators for the monitoring of cross-border urban planning in the tri-national agglomeration of Basel

A final event organized in France, aimed at showcasing the results achieved by the partners, to maximise the impacts of the action and extend them beyond the regions concerned
